

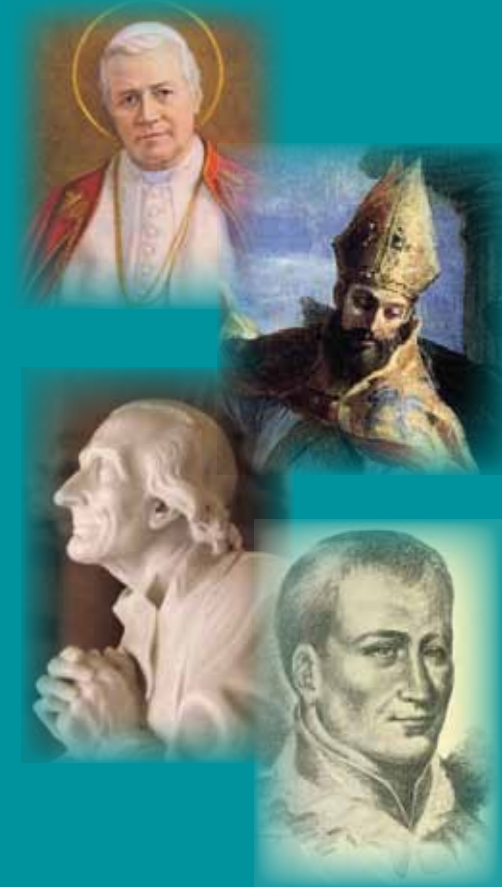

ABOUT THE MAIN SPEAKER

Dr. Lawrence Feingold is a lay theologian and specialist in the thought of St. Thomas Aquinas. He received a B.A. in Comparative Arts from Washington University in St. Louis, MO, and a Master's degree in Art History at Columbia University. In 1989 he converted to Catholicism together with his wife. From 1990-99, he studied Philosophy and Theology at the Pontifical University of the Holy Cross in Rome, earning a doctorate in Dogmatic Theology. From 1999 to 2004, Dr. Feingold taught Philosophy and Theology in the House of Formation of *Miles Christi* in Argentina. Currently he is Assistant Professor of Pastoral Theology in the Institute for Pastoral Theology of Ave Maria University.
