



As we prepare to once again host guests at Spirit in the Desert, we are aware of the concerns arriving guests are going to have regarding the steps we are taking to keep them safe. Here are some of the procedures that are being implemented:

- All rooms and public areas will be sanitized using an electrostatic sanitization system that kills germs, bacteria, and viruses.
- Pillows will be sterilized after each guest stay using an intense UVC lighting system
- Keys will be sterilized using an intense UVC lighting system.
- Hand sanitizer stations are being installed throughout the campus
- All “high touch” areas will be cleaned often using appropriate chemicals to disinfect the area.
- Public restrooms will feature no touch soap dispensers and no touch paper towel dispensers
- Individual soap bars will replace liquid soap dispenser in the showers.
- Employees will take and log their temperature before starting work each day.
- Employees will wear masks when interacting with guests, working in guest rooms or public areas or serving food.

Each group will decide for themselves in how they choose to deal with the number of guests per room, whether masks will be worn, and how rooms are set up to deal with social distancing.
